The Course

Are you hoping to pursue a career within the uniformed public services? This course will prepare you for employment, ensuring that you have the relevant knowledge and skills to progress to degree level study should you wish. It includes work experience with a range of public services to build your experience. If you know what career path you want to take in the public services, this is the course for you. Year 1

- > Carry out map reading and navigation across open country
- > Develop aspects of physical fitness
- > Equality, diversity and inclusion
- > Values and standards (Diploma only)
- > Develop leadership skills

- > Prepare for a career in chosen uniformed public service
- > Understand the impact of war and conflict (Diploma Only)
- > Emergency planning and response in the uniformed services

Year 2

- > Skills for land-based activities
- > Crime scene investigation
- > Volunteering in the uniformed services
- > Collaboration (Extended Diploma only)
- > Understanding discipline (Extended Diploma only)

Entry Requirements

You will need four GCSEs at grade 4 or C or equivalent, preferably including English and Maths, or a relevant BTEC Level 2 qualification. A satisfactory reference is also needed.

Work Experience

You will be expected to find a suitable one-week placement in the public service industry. The college also runs a two-week residential at Strensall Army Barracks.

How You're Assessed

You will be assessed using a variety of methods, including presentations, written reports, role plays, voice recordings, video presentations, practical sessions, observations and posters.
