This is how providers in the region have worked together to address skills needs include the following examples:

Institute of Technology (YHIoT)

Yorkshire & Humber Institute of Technology specialises in providing higher-level technical education and training. The Institute is based on a collaborative partnership between a number of colleges, universities and employers in the region. Partners are working together to deliver and develop higher-level curriculum in digital, engineering and manufacturing, construction and agri-tech subjects.

Local Skills Improvement Fund (LSIF)

Led by York College, the LSIF has been a key opportunity for collaborative activity between providers. Based on Local Skills Improvement Plan (LSIP) recommendations, the area has focused on these key priority areas to address through LSIF funding:
